Always be honest.


Work hard - both in training and matches.

HOW WE COACH

PHYSICAL ACTIVATION ANALYTICAL PHASE

We initially concentrate on the nurturing of physical gestures that directly link to skilfull execution during game scenarios.

TECHNICAL, DYNAMIC AND APPLIED PHASE

Technique is the foundation of everything that we do.

We then introduce unopposed technical practices, with links to the previously learnt technical gestures.

These are then applied in various settings that link back to the game.

SITUATIONAL GAME PHASE

We then progress by taking all that has been learnt and applied in the previous phases and aim to perform them under various levels of pressure within an array of tactical game-related scenarios.

CONDITIONED GAME PHASE

Players then can express and apply all that has been worked upon in a competitive environment.

This embodies the potential for varying conditions to promote the topic and repetition of key learning objectives.

IN POSSESSION

Whenever possible, players will be encouraged to play through the three zones of the pitch - controlling, connecting and combining ball possession with clever and creative play.

Our style of play will encourage all players to contribute to attacking play at different times - with an emphasis on intelligence, innovation, the technical skill of the individual, and the ability to dominate all 1 v 1 situations.

OUT OF POSSESSION

Players will be encouraged to recognise how, when, and where to secure, retain, maintain and progress ball possession by being compact, controlled, and calculated.

Our style of play will encourage all players to defend intelligently and aggressively, in order to dictate opposition ball possession - whilst confidently dominating all 1 v 1 situations.

IN TRANSITION

Players will be encouraged to be positive, proactive, reactive, and responsive to all changes in ball possession.

The way we play the game will allow all players to positively apply or respond to the first and second ball contacts in all three zones.

OVERVIEW

WHAT DOES A MACCLESFIELD FC JUNIOR ACADEMY TRAINING SESSION CONSISTENT OF?

A typical Macclesfield FC Junior Academy training session is designed to challenge players from a physical, psychological, technical and tactical perspective.

Each session can be broken down into these four key components - within which, specific attributes are introduced, explored and expanded upon.



These components are directly and logically linked to the next, creating a clear and coherent flow for each player.

Each exercise demands physical gestures, skilful execution and conceptual understanding that all relate back to the game.

We present these as challenges to the players and their task is to provide solutions - whilst being put under a range of different pressures and scenarios.

With each exercise methodically linking to the next, our

training sessions mirror that also and take their place within the overall Macclesfield FC Junior Academy curriculum and long-term plan for player development.

In terms of the matches that our Junior Academy teams compete in, we see these as an extension of the training programme.

Within which, players can trial, apply and express all that they have learned in a competitive environment.

WHAT DOES A MINI MASTERCLASS CONSIST OF?

A Mini Masterclass involves a small sub-group of players (2 - 5) who are similar in age, ability and game understanding.

They come together to train with specialist coaches for a one-hour period and are able to take their development to the next level.

Not only do players benefit from the relationships that they form with their teammates, but they also get to enjoy a coach : player ratio that maximises individual contact time.

This allows for specific physical, technical and tactical feedback to be given in order to enhance the learning process.

Our 4G surface not only provides a phenomenal platform for all our players to express themselves on, but its all-weather properties



An Individual Learning Plan (ILP) is a tailored and meticulously constructed document that is provided to all members of our Junior Academy.

It both supplements and enhances their

development with us and represents a fundamental part of everything that we do.

The ILP is formulated through meetings with three key stakeholders the coach, the parent, and most importantly, the player.

In these meetings, the player's strengths





and areas for development are discussed and agreed upon. To do this, we utilise a range of methodologies including coaches' insight, training / match footage and self-evaluation.

The aim is to take these strengths and turn them into what we call "Super Strengths".

Players will also be set "Smart Goals" where areas of development can be worked upon in an achievable and measurable manner within their existing training programme.

DEVELOPMENT CENTRE (U7 - U16)

During a young player's footballing journey, there will be many twists and turns along the way. Through the implementation of our Development Centre, we can provide targeted and inspiring opportunities for all within the Macclesfield FC pathway system.

In demanding a true appreciation and understanding of individual player development, we are able to support each young player at every stage of their journey with us and provide a tangible pathway into our Elite Academy system.

ELITE ACADEMY

If selected, Development Centre players will be offered the opportunity to join Macclesfield FC's Elite Academy - across all the different phases of the game.

These are outlined below and highlight the clear pathway that ends at First Team level.

DISCOVERY PHASE (U7 - U11) - LOVE THE GAME

During the formulative years of a child's footballing experience, Macclesfield FC Junior Academy provides a solid platform - upon which, our young players can experiment and express themselves in an open and positive environment.

Simply put, we help all our players fall in love with the game.

COMPETITION PHASE (U12 - U16) - LEARN THE GAME

During the adolescent years of a child's footballing experience, Macclesfield FC Junior Academy provides a distinct platform that encompasses all that has been learnt applied during the Discovery Phase.

This is both consolidated and extended through the introduction of competitive matches.

Focus will not necessarily be placed on results, but players will be encouraged to develop a love of winning in addition to their overall passion for the game in general.

PERFORMANCE PHASE (U17 - U21) - LIVE THE GAME

During the latter stages of a young adult's footballing experience, we will provide a platform that compliments all that has been learnt and applied as part of the Discovery and Competition Phases.

Providing an insight into the senior game, players will be provided with the opportunities to showcase their talents and increase their understanding of the game in a variety of competitive and educational settings.

Through this, we will inspire all our players to take an active participation in the game which is lifelong.



JUNIOR ACADEMY TERMS & CONDITIONS

GENERAL POLICY

- The minimum age for enrolment at Macclesfield FC Junior Academy is six years. The maximum age for enrolment is 18 years. Management may make exceptions for players where appropriate.
- Smoking is strictly prohibited at Macclesfield FC during any Junior Academy activities.
- Macclesfield FC Junior Academy players and parents must respect the property, facilities, and services offered by the Academy, hence damaging any property and/or facility or equipment is prohibited.
- Use of abusive language and/or violence in any form against other players, parents, coaches, visitors, and/or Macclesfield FC Junior Academy staff is strictly prohibited. Any such incidents will be reported to Management and will result in immediate expulsion from the Academy without refund.
- By providing their email addresses and telephone numbers, parents consent to receive Macclesfield FC news, promotional campaigns, alerts, and updates via email, phone, and SMS.
- Macclesfield FC will provide a safe environment; however, customers

acknowledge that players play at their own risk. Macclesfield FC is not responsible for any injuries to players during training sessions, matches, and activities.

- Macclesfield FC is not responsible for any lost property or property left unattended.
- Lost property will be placed within a "lost and found box" and if the item is unclaimed by the end of the respective term, it will be given to a local charity.
- Long lens photography is not permitted on site.
- Macclesfield FC retains the right to withdraw any player should that player and/or related parent fail to adhere to these Terms and Conditions.

TRAINING / MATCHDAY POLICY

- Macclesfield FC Junior Academy will choose to operate throughout the calendar year (excluding Bank and Public Holidays).
- Parents will be notified via email/ message of any changes/ amendments to the training timetable.
- Parents will be notified via email/ message of a player's selection for an external matchday squad and

parents must confirm their availability by the deadline provided by Macclesfield FC Junior Academy staff.

- Failure to confirm a player's attendance will result in the player being removed from the matchday squad.
- Once a player's attendance is confirmed, failure to attend an external match without prior notification may result in a onematch ban.
- Players and/or parents are expected to arrange their own travel to external matches unless otherwise advised by Macclesfield FC Junior Academy staff.
- Arrival at training sessions must be at least 15 minutes prior to the start time.
- Parents are welcome to attend training sessions and fixtures as spectators - however, we ask that there is no parental intervention at any point.
- Any accompanying children must be supervised by the parent(s) at all times.

MAKE-UP SESSIONS / REFUND POLICY

- All players must enter a monthly payment plan either via debit or credit card. This guarantees the player's place within the Academy system.
- If the debit/credit card payment fails, payment must be made in cash.
- Junior Academy training fees are non-refundable, except in circumstances approved by Management.
- Each refund request will be looked at individually and will have no relation to any other refund request.

- The annual membership fee of £195 is strictly non-refundable (Competition Phase).
- Used player kits are strictly nonrefundable.
- If a player misses a session, then they can be made up if the sessions are missed due to cancellation by Macclesfield FC Junior Academy.
- If a player misses a session for any other reason, they will not be entitled to any make-up session and the matter will be at Management's discretion.
- Should any player wish to leave Macclesfield FC Junior Academy, then a one-month written notice period is required.

KIT POLICY

- Players must wear the official Macclesfield FC Junior Academy player's kit.
- Players may be stopped from participating in training sessions, matches, and/or other activities if they are not wearing the correct kit.
- Appropriate footwear must be worn at all times - with metal studs prohibited on the 4G surface.
- Players must wear shin pads at all times during training sessions and matches.
- Player kits may only be exchanged if they are unused and if the original tag is still on the items.
- If a player requires a replacement kit or an additional kit throughout the season, this must be purchased.
